Carol Ganick Demo Tuesday May 20, 6:30pm Avon Town Hall, 60 West Main Street



Carol Ganick will demonstrate painting flowers in watercolor at Avon Town Hall, Tues. May 20, free to the public (\$5 suggested donation). Her workshop will be on Sat. May 25, 10am - 2pm (\$45 for members, \$55 for non-members).



Carol Ganick has taught watercolor at the West Hartford Art League for over 30 years. Her work is generally characterized by a strong use of gestural brush strokes. Some of her classes focus on composition and painting principles, others stress practice and mastery of techniques.

Carol was one of the Arts Council's 2019 Featured Artists. Each year, the Arts Council picks a work from two local visual artists to create prints that are given to supporters of the United Arts Campaign.

Carol always encourages her students at West Hartford Art League to be brave, and to "be carefree when putting paint to paper." She says this mindset allows for more discovery. For her, teaching provides the incentive to find different ways to approach a material, subject, or medium. "You learn more from your mistakes than from doing things correctly every time."

During her demo on May 20, she will talk about some of the difficulties and benefits of working with this medium. Her workshop will provide an introduction to watercolor painting, including a lesson in painting flowers.
